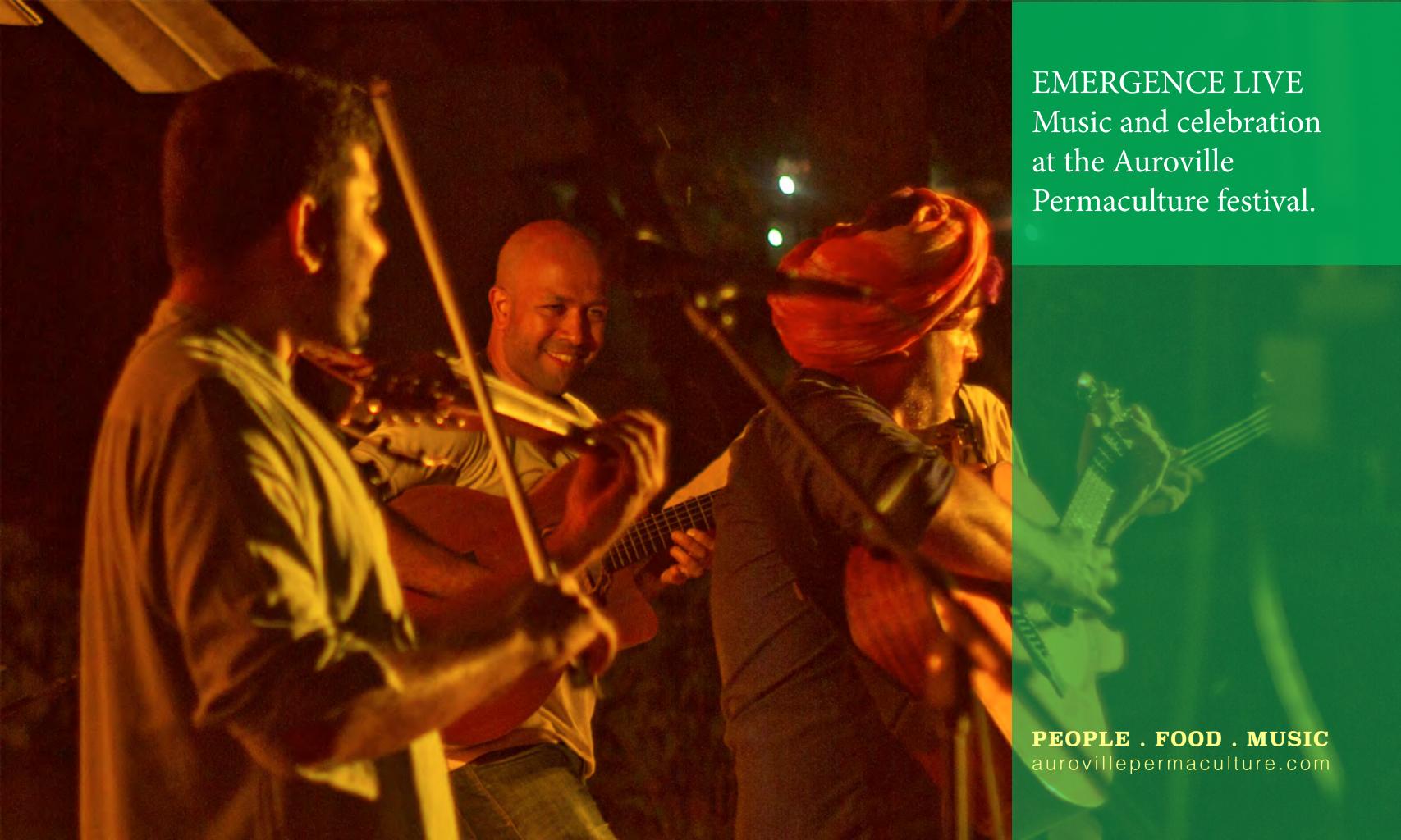




























## **People Food Music**
